An "Act 48-approved" 15-hour workshop to help educators fully utilize Pennsylvania's newest curriculum module, "Pennsylvania Amphibians and Reptiles," will be held at Powdermill Nature Reserve, biological field station of Carnegie Museum of Natural History, beginning Friday evening March 28. The curriculum module, which was published by the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission in 2001, was developed by educators for educators with a grant from Pennsylvania's Wild Resource Conservation Fund.
