The Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission and Wildwood Lake Sanctuary in Dauphin County will sponsor "Project WILD Aquatics", a workshop for teachers and informal educators, on Wednesday, June 14 from 8:30 AM until 4 PM. In this workshop, educators will learn about Pennsylvania's aquatic resources and receive classroom activities useful in teaching that content. In the afternoon, educators will participate in a stream study that will include macroinvertebrate identification along with water sampling and testing. Pennsylvania teachers are eligible for 7 hours of Act 48 credit. Participants should bring a lunch. Snacks and beverages will be provided. Deadline for registration is June 7. There will be a fee of \$10 per person. Space is limited and pre-registration is required. To register, call the Olewine Nature Center at 717/221-0292.

The PA Fish and Boat Commission in cooperation with Little Buffalo State Park will present a PA Amphibians and Reptile Workshop on Wednesday and Thursday, July 26th and 27th at Little Buffalo SP. The workshop will include classroom activities, wonderful references and a curriculum guide. The amphibians and reptiles curriculum guide is a multi-disciplinary curriculum designed for classroom educators of grades K-12. Pennsylvania teachers are eligible for Act 48 credits. The guide is divided into four units: Awareness (basic biology), Identification, Habitat and Responsible Human Action. Participants in this workshop receive a copy of the curriculum guide: Pennsylvania Amphibians and Reptiles. Participants also receive an introduction to the biology, ecology and identification of PA's herps.
